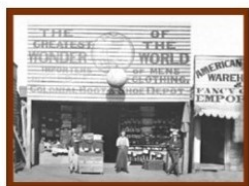

VISIT BY THE GERMAN DEPUTY CONSUL GENERAL

Early in our quest to establish the Gulgong Holtermann Museum, we took the concept of acknowledging the involvement of the German pioneers in the NSW gold rush of the 1870's to the Consulate General of the Federal Republic of Germany. The committee highlighted the activities of Bernhard Otto Holtermann, his vision for the NSW goldfields and his photographic achievements. This concept was of interest to the Federal Republic of Germany as they are active in assisting in the preservation of their German heritage worldwide.

In July 2019, we had a visit by the German Deputy Consul General, Klaus Steitz, to sign documentation for a generous grant by the Federal Republic of Germany to be utilised for part of the interactive Museum displays.
